Community Unit School District 303 offers both Half Day and All Day Kindergarten programs. All Day Kindergarten is a tuition-based program for the additional 1/2 day and requires a non-refundable \$50.00 registration deposit to ensure placement. Information regarding All Day Kindergarten tuition for the 2012-2013 school year will be available before February 8.

The following information is required when registering for kindergarten:

- A certified copy of the student's original birth certificate
- Verification of Parent/Guardian Identity (Photo ID)
- Two documents as proof of residency*
- Parcel Identification Number (PIN)*

Complete information about physical examinations, dental examinations and immunizations will be available at the February registration. Students are expected to have all requirements completed by the first day of school. Tentative student assignments will be made by June. Final student assignments will be posted in August.
